Brief objective of event:

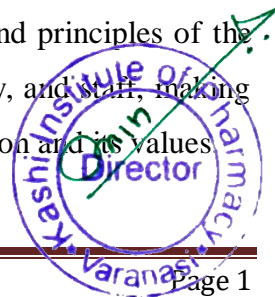
